#### NEW PLANS ON THE HORIZON

With a new year starting there are new things brewing. The main set of plans I want to mention in this article are related to the new build for a Memory Care Unit attached to our existing Assisted Living wing.

To be clear, what this means is that on SMRC campus we would offer 2 levels of care for residents struggling with dementia or Alzheimer's Disease. Currently in our Health Care wing we are licensed for 14 units at the lower functioning levels, (step 3, 4 or 5). The new build would cater to the early stages of dementia (step 1 and 2) in small apartments with a focus on the common areas for gathering spaces. Our goal is to create continuity with programming for both units. This new build would operate under Assisted Living regulations.

When communicating with our architect this month, we established a tentative time frame. There is site work to be completed and building approval needed from the state over the next 90 days. Late spring is the tentative plan for construction to begin with a completion date at the end of 2023. The unit will provide housing and services for 12 residents.

Financially here is how we line up:


This will not cover the entire cost to complete this project, however, it substantially reduces the borrowed funds needed. Thank you to our loyal donors for their continued support!

Sunshine Meadows is blessed to have **physical** 

therapy specialists within our facility.

**GOOD SERVICE:** Over the past 20 years, Sunshine Meadows has contracted with various physical therapy companies to provide rehabilitation services within the nursing facility, for the benefit of our residents at Sunshine Meadows, as well as our employees and the community at large.

**20 YEARS MAKING IT WORK:** SMRC provided PT in various places, finally settling on the northeast side of the building, close to parking spaces for handicapped individuals as well as those requiring PT. Those gravel parking spaces recently were paved in order to make walking safe, thanks to a grant. Various equipment was purchased through other grants. In these past 20 years, Sunshine Meadows has been

"making it work" - but our residents and community deserve a better space to get better in.

At this point, **it's time to re-paint**, **add better lighting**, **and re-carpet** this somewhat dreary space; also, the walls of the office and consultation rooms don't reach the ceiling. We need to complete these rooms to **provide some private spaces for consultation**. In addition, the closest short set of stairs to use to prepare for the return home requires therapists to walk patients a long distance in the facility. **A set of safe stairs in the PT area**, as seen in the photo, will keep patients from using all of their energy in the walk, rather than focusing on the challenge of stairs. We hope to

raise \$12,000 to revitalize this space.
